WEEK 12 SYLLABUS

Monday

Finish writing your rough draft of your Medieval Analysis Paper. Post your rough draft in the “Medieval Analysis Paper” Board as a reply to your outline. When you post, ask questions for your peer to get help in weak areas.

Tuesday

- 1) Complete a Peer Content Review on a peer’s paper. Go to the topic “Medieval Analysis Paper,” and critique a peer based on the points listed below. In order to receive full homework credit, you must provide answers to each item. Partners are listed in the Course Information Board under “Partner and Topic Assignments.” Remember, you **MUST** do this, even if you didn’t post your own paper. This is worth 20 points. Your grade will reflect your ability to provide quality and thorough help. If an item does not need to be changed, specifically say so or your coach might think you forgot to check for it. Here is what you need to respond to:
 - Answer any questions your peer asked.
 - Ask quality questions and tell where descriptive details, inner ideas, and manipulating time are needed and/or how they could be more fully developed.
 - Does it have a strong thesis statement? Does the thesis statement explain the paper, and does the paper revolve around the thesis?
 - Does it have sufficient examples/illustrations to prove the analysis? Where are more needed?

Wednesday

- 1) Review the attachment “Introduction to Victorianism & Realism”—if you took Literature 2, you have already read this, but please re-look at it (if you are seeing it for the first time, please read more carefully!). This is located in the Course Information folder under Literature Documents.
- 2) Read the attachment “Literature Development Around the World.”
- 3) Read the attachment “Realism Across the Globe.”
- 4) Read the story “Two Friends.” Answer the questions found in the file “Two Friends Discussion Questions.” Comment on the insights of your classmates to earn your QDPPs. You have until Friday to complete your QDPPs.

Thursday-Friday

- 1) **Prepare for your coach conference.**
 - In your paper, delete your partner's comments as you go so you have a clean copy. **Remember:** if you doubt the necessity of something your peer suggests regarding your inner ideas, manipulating time, similes/metaphors, or what to cut, turn it into a question for your next coach conference.
 - Come up with three or more questions to ask your coach about your paper. Look at the "Coach Conferences" document for ideas of what to ask.

- 2) Post your NEWEST version AND your questions for your coach in the **CONFERENCE ROOM** by midnight Friday. This assignment is worth 25 points: you will get 5 points for posting on time; 10 points for asking your coach questions; and 10 points for attempting to revise from your peer's review comments. It is always permissible to post early, but you will receive a deduction if you are late!
